# Season 2005


- Freezing at the end of winter and dryness : extreme conditions in certain areas which compromise harvest in qualitative and quantitative terms
- Arrival of the first raspberries at the end of May – at the beginning of June with the early varieties such as Glen Lyon, Glen Moy, Elided
- Semi June fresh weather limits volumes, first out of earth Meekers come to supplement the range

- From the end of June, full-field Meekers appear. Orientation of a part of volumes towards industry. Storms compromise the quality of the production of certain areas

- During July, dull market

- The market of the « remontantes » varieties is reactivated as from semi August

# Economic Organization Production (Tonnes)


